The Manhattan Transfer has achieved an incomparable career of pop and jazz hits, a legacy that defines the group as it celebrates its 50th Anniversary. The legendary quartet has won 10 Grammy Awards out of 20 nominations and has been inducted into the Vocal Group Hall of Fame.

With their current release *FIFTY* (Concord/Craft Recordings), the group has earned its 21st Grammy nomination, this one for Best Jazz Vocal Album! The London review of their SOLD OUT show on Nov. 24th heralded the group:

"The musicianship is breathtakingly good – their intricate close-harmony singing is stunning, the arrangements top-notch. And they make it look so easy, which it isn't." Recorded with the WDR Funkhausorchester during the pandemic, on two continents, the music celebrates their many transitions, recognizing their musicality and versatility – they treated pop tunes like jazz tunes and jazz tunes like pop! Their inductions this year into the East Coast Music Hall of Fame and the Vocal Music Hall of Fame recognized their incredible history.

In 1981, they became the first group ever to win Grammys in both Pop and Jazz categories in the same year – Best Pop Performance by a Duo or Group with Vocal for "Boy From New York City" and Best Jazz Performance for Duo or Group for "Until I Met You (Corner Pocket)." The dozen Grammy nominations they received for their Vocalese album in 1985 were second to Michael Jackson's Thriller as the most nominated album in one year.

Their dynamic performances and sense of style have led them to become one of

the most iconic music groups in the world. With their enduring creativity, energy, and joy in their music, the group has joined the pantheon of the entertainment industry. Recognized for their unique sound, The Manhattan Transfer has also recorded with an impressive array of artists, including Tony Bennett, Bette Midler, Smokey Robinson, Laura Nyro, Phil Collins, B.B. King, Chaka Khan, James Taylor, and Frankie Valli.

The group was born when Tim Hauser was paying his bills as a New York City cab driver. He aspired to form a vocal harmony quartet that could authentically embrace a variety of musical styles and still create something unique in American popular music. In his taxi he met the next members of the group – Laurel Massé and Janis Siegel. Alan Paul, who was appearing in the Broadway cast of Grease at the time, was recommended as an additional male voice. The four of them became The Manhattan Transfer on October 1st, 1972.

Soon after their inception, the group began performing regularly throughout New York City – at underground clubs including Trude Heller's, the Mercer Arts Center, Max's Kansas City, Club 82, and other cabaret venues. Quickly, they were the number one live attraction in Manhattan. They were signed to Atlantic Records and released their self-titled debut album in 1975. The second single from that album, a cover of the gospel classic "Operator," gave the group its first national hit. More hits, like "The Boy From New York City," "Twilight Zone/Twilight Tone," followed. The vocal remake of the jazz classic "Birdland" became the group's anthem and earned them their first two Grammy Awards.

Cheryl Bentyne joined The Manhattan Transfer in 1979, replacing Laurel. Trist Curless became a member of the group in 2014. Together, Janis, Alan, Cheryl, and Trist have remained true to the integrity and artistry left to them by founding member Tim Houser, who passed away in 2014.

The group has released 19 singles and 29 albums over their incredible career and their music has been widely featured in major films and television shows. Their 50th Anniversary celebration will see the release of *FIFTY*, the new album, and a 5-disc historic CD boxed set.

With sold-out world tours and record sales in the millions, The Manhattan Transfer continues to bring unique and extraordinary melodic and jazz-infused vocals to new and established audiences, spanning generations.





Néstor Torres

N éstor Torres, the accomplished flautist from Puerto Rico, has left an indelible mark on the world of music through his remarkable journey. With a background spanning classical, jazz, and Cuban dance music, Torres stands as a testament to the transcendence of musical boundaries.

Born in Mayaguez, Puerto Rico, Torres embarked on a musical odyssey that would see him master the flute across diverse genres. His journey began with classical flute studies at New York City's Mannes School of Music. However, Torres sought to expand his horizons, diving into jazz at Berklee College of Music and further embracing both classical and jazz at the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston.

During this period, Torres made a pivotal decision to immerse himself in the 'Charanga' Cuban dance music style. This choice significantly influenced his musical identity, infusing it with a melodic and irresistibly danceable quality.

Torres' musical journey yielded impressive results, including 14 solo recordings, 4 Latin Grammy nominations, one Grammy nomination, and the coveted Latin Grammy Award. His discography showcases a fusion of Latin, classical, jazz, and pop influences, resulting in a rich and engaging tapestry of sound.

What sets Néstor Torres apart is not just his studio achievements but also his captivating live performances. His stage presence and ability to create immersive musical experiences reaffirm his status as a force to be reckoned with in the world of jazz flute. Collaborations with artists like Gloria Estefan, Kenny Loggins, Dave Matthews, Herbie Hancock, Tito Puente, Michel Camilo, Paquito D' Rivera, and Arturo Sandoval highlight his versatility and ability to harmonize with diverse musical sensibilities.

Additionally, Torres' orchestral performances with prestigious ensembles like the Cleveland, Singapore, and New World Symphony Orchestras demonstrate the depth of his musicality and the universal appeal of his flute artistry.

A pivotal moment in Torres' career was winning the Latin Grammy for his album "This Side Of Paradise" in the Pop instrumental category. The timing of this achievement, scheduled for September 11, 2001, proved to be poignant, showcasing his music's ability to transcend boundaries and offer solace during times of global turmoil.

Beyond his accomplishments as a musician, Néstor Torres has become an agent of change, using his talents to bridge cultures and promote understanding. His compositions, including "Successors," "Marta y Maria," and "Disarmament Suite," commissioned by institutions such as the Miami Children's Chorus, St. Martha-Yamaha Concert Series, and ICAP (International Committee of Artists for Peace), reflect his commitment to multicultural fusion as a means of expressing the complex tapestry of today's world.

Nestor Torres' contributions extend beyond music. He has been recognized for his dedication to youth, education, and cultural exchanges, receiving two honorary doctorate degrees from Barry University and Carlos Albizu University.

In the words of Ralph A. Mirello from the Huffington Post, Néstor Torres is undeniably a remarkable player, and his "live" recordings serve as a testament to the excitement and joy he generates through his music. For anyone who loves jazz flute or seeks to explore the rich repertoire of jazz flute traditions, Néstor Torres is a must-have experience.

Néstor Torres' rhythmic and mellifluous flute sound stands apart in the world of music, showcasing the power of artistic expression to transcend boundaries and enrich lives. His journey exemplifies the limitless possibilities of musical exploration and the enduring impact of an artist dedicated to breaking down barriers through the universal language of music.

Tierney Sutton Band

An 8-time Grammy nominee,
Sutton has received 7 consecutive
nominations for "Best Jazz Vocal Album"a nomination for every project she has
released for the last decade. In 2013 she
released After Blue, a jazz-inspired reimagining of the legacy of Joni Mitchell.
The album received wide acclaim and was

Sutton's breakout as a leader without her longtime Band, and features Al Jarreau, Hubert Laws, Peter Erskine, Larry Goldings, Mark Summer, Kevin Axt, Serge Merlaud and The Turtle Island String Quartet.

With a recording and touring history spanning over 20 years and 9 CDs, The Tierney Sutton Band, "TSB" has traveled a rare path. Comprised of Sutton and instrumental virtuosos C. V. Dashiell,

Trey Henry and Christian Jacob, the band functions as a true collaborative (and legally incorporated) unit and makes all musical as well as business decisions as partners. In 2011 the TSB received a Grammy nomination for it's collaborative arranging, the only collaborative team ever to receive that honor.

Their discography is thematic and rich and past TSB projects have addressed: *Americana* (American Road, 2011) *Materialism* (Desire, 2009), *The Pursuit of Happiness* (On The Other Side, 2007), as well as the musical legacies of Bill Evans (*Blue in Green*,

2001) and Frank Sinatra (*Dancing in The Dark*, 2003). Along these same lines, TSB released a new recording in Fall 2016, *The Sting Variations*. In addition to this, Christian Jacob and TSB scored

the original music for Clint Eastwood's feature flim "Sully", starring Tom Hanks and Laura Linney. The film premiered on September 9, 2016.

Tierney has headlined in recent years at The Hollywood Bowl, Carnegie Hall, The Kennedy Center and Jazz At Lincoln Center. She can also be heard on film and television soundtracks including that of The Academy Award-nominated film "The Cooler" as well as on television commercials (BMW, Green Giant, Yoplait Yogurt, Coke)

When she is off the road, Tierney is in demand as both a producer and vocal educator. She taught for over a decade at USC's Thornton School of Music and served for 5 years as Vocal Department Head at The Los Angeles College of Music in Pasadena, CA where she created a new curriculum for vocalists of all genres. Tierney has taught and mentored some of music's finest new generation of singers including Gretchen Parlato and Sara Gazarek.

"With certain singers, it's possible to pinpoint the specific recordings that marked the transition from great to iconic. As with Ella Fitzgerald's Songbooks for Norman Granz or Frank Sinatra's initial teaming with Nelson Riddle at Capital, Tierney Sutton's sixth disc is her passport into the classic... Sutton's brilliance is her ability to blend seamlessly with the three superlative bandmates - pianist Christian Jacob, bassist Trey Henry (here alternating with Kevin Axt) and drummer Ray Brinker - who have been integral to her escalating success for more than a decade. Providing a continuous flow of support, strength and inspiration, they are her Granz, her Riddle."

es, a native of Brooklyn, NY, launched ✓ his career at age 16 as drummer for jazz vibraphone great, Lionel Hampton. He toured for 12 years with jazz trumpet master, Harry James, and recorded three albums with him including the Grammy Award winning, "King James Version". Les' own jazz/rock/fusion band, Transfusion, recorded five award-winning LPs. He has toured with The Manhattan Transfer and appeared with such musical greats as Lou Rawls, Sammy Davis, Jr., Frank Sinatra, Mel Tormé, and Joe Williams. A resident of Amelia Island since 1991, Les continues to perform at concerts, festivals and Jazz cruises with his trio, quartet and Dynamic Les DeMerle Big Band Orchestra featuring Bonnie Eisele. They have recorded 16 CDs including the new release, SOUND 67 Once *In a Lifetime* on Origin Records.

As an author, Les has written two bestselling educational drum books: "Jazz/Rock Fusion, Volumes I and II", published by Hal Leonard. In addition he produced a twopart instructional drum videos, "Jazz Drum Set Applications, Parts I & II", to impart his extensive knowledge to drummers around the world. He extends his teachings via private in-person and on-line lessons and ongoing appearances at drum clinics nationwide.

In 2001, Les' longtime dream of creating a diversified jazz festival on Amelia Island came to fruition. He and his wife Bonnie produced the Festival for three years prior to its incorporation as a non-profit 501(c) 3 tax exempt organization. With the help of generous sponsors and hardworking volunteers, the Amelia Island Jazz Festival has grown into an event which attracts major jazz artists and attendees from across the country. But Les insists there will be more. "We're still growing" he says, "and we continue towards our goal of building the festival into a nationally recognized annual event."


Bonnie Eisele

Wife of Les DeMerle, Bonnie is the featured vocalist with the Dynamic Les DeMerle Band, from trio to 17-piece orchestra, currently appearing in Jazz Clubs, concerts, festivals, corporate engagements and as a guest entertainer on cruise ships. She has performed with Les DeMerle at many popular jazz clubs including Somerset's in Singapore, City Jazz in Orlando, The Jazz Corner in Hilton Head, Arturo Sandoval's in Miami, Breezy Jazz House in Jacksonville and Venice Jazz Club in Italy.

Bonnie has recorded 15 studio and live CDs as featured vocalist for the Dynamic Les DeMerle Band. She is admirably comfortable with a wide range of material in four languages. Her extensive and tasteful repertoire transcends all forms of jazz artistry, from Swing to Latin. No matter the type of song, Bonnie injects a distinctive and soulful style into its performance.

L PT, a dynamic 10-piece band hailing from Jacksonville, FL, is all about high energy. Over the past four years, they've electrified stages across the Southeast, from New Orleans to Atlanta and Savannah, making festival appearances their norm. Lead vocalist Josue A. Cruz notes the upgrade in dressing rooms, humorously implying their growing success. Opening for Santana and Trombone Shorty expanded their reach.

Now, LPT is ready to conquer the music world with their debut album, "Sin Parar," featuring nine original compositions ranging from intricate to jaw-dropping salsa. This album promises to captivate both seasoned salsa enthusiasts and newcomers alike.

In June 2015, LPT debuted in a small Riverside coffee shop in Jacksonville, wowing the standing-room-only crowd. Monthly gigs at Rain Dogs followed, but the demand outgrew the venue. Early fans shared tips on where to stand and dance during packed shows. LPT's growth led to a full ten-piece orchestra, with bigger stages beckoning.

Their infectious energy transcends Jacksonville, spreading to St. Augustine and Gainesville. Requests from even farther away are pouring in. Despite the logistical challenges of a ten-piece band, LPT embraces their role as salsa ambassadors, bridging cultural divides. They believe that dance and joy belong to everyone and aim to promote freedom, love, and inclusion through salsa music.

As for the mysterious name "LPT," its meaning remains undisclosed. Some say it's simply three letters side by side, while others offer more playful interpretations. Regardless, LPT will continue to champion salsa music and the Afro-Cuban sound's roots.
